Please read your Rules and Regulations to see what the committee will be looking for in the area of lot maintenance. Thanks....Maybe this year there will be no violations....that would be fantastic. If you are an owner who is not in the park, have someone you know check your lot and there are services that you can contact to do the lot maintenance for you and if you rent your lot it is a lot easier to do the maintenance before your renter is on the lot.
